

Lyon, France, May 11 – Infogrames Entertainment has announced that it had received letters on May 9, 2007 notifying the Company of the crossing of disclosure thresholds by a shareholder (as required by article L. 233-7 of the Commercial Code).

Morgan Stanley & Co. International Plc (of 20 Cabot Square, Canary Wharf, London E14 4QW, United Kingdom) reported that its position had:

- declined below the limit of 5% of the shares and voting rights of Infogrames Entertainment on May 2, 2007, when it held 54,082,656 Infogrames Entertainment shares with an equal number of voting rights, representing 4.38% of the Company's shares outstanding and 4.37% of its voting rights (1)
- exceeded the limit of 5% of the shares and voting rights of Infogrames Entertainment on May 7, 2007, when it held 93,435,312 Infogrames Entertainment shares with an equal number of voting rights, representing 7.58% of the Company's shares outstanding and 7.55% of its voting rights (1);

The positions resulted primarily from stock borrowing and lending transactions.
