

CHANGES IN THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Lyon, France, November 29, 2006 – Infogrames Entertainment notes that the shareholders' meeting of November 15 elected two new members to the Company's board of directors:

- **Gina Germano**. Germano joined BlueBay in April 2002 from Lazard Asset Management in New York, where from 1998 she was a portfolio manager responsible for European high yield securities. From 1996 to 1998, Germano was an equity research analyst at Morgan Stanley in New York. She holds degrees from Boston University and Northwestern University and a Master's degree from the University of Lund in Sweden.

- **BlueBay Asset Management represented by Eli Muraidekh**. Prior to joining BlueBay Asset Management Plc, Muraidekh was the General Partner of Elwin Capital Partners, a global private equity fund, which he founded in 2000. From 1994 to 2000, he was a senior investment professional with Goldman Sachs in New York and London. Prior to Goldman Sachs, he worked with McKinsey in London and Morgan Stanley in New York. Muraidekh holds an MBA from the Harvard Business School and a BA in Economics from Yale University.

Infogrames Entertainment also announced that Claude de Saint Vincent had resigned from the board of directors for personal reasons. Efforts will continue to be made to find outside directors willing to help the Company attain its strategic objectives, while at the same time strengthening its corporate governance.
